MAKING DISCIPLES

Jesus is in the business of making disciples and then, transforming the disciples into apostles. Disciples are students looking to their designated teacher for instruction and guidance. When the student is ready to go out on his or her own, they are sent forth as teachers themselves.

The lectionary gospel text for this week is Jesus beginning to call his first disciples. Their journey together will not end on the hill of Calvary. Even after Jesus' ascension, the Holy Advocate, the Holy Spirit for which God sent in Jesus' place will remind us of Jesus' teachings. (John 14)

The Holy Spirit is firing on all cylinders in a community in Dallas, Texas. One middle school of 900 kids wanted to have a "Breakfast with Dads" event before school began but they received little interest from the kids because many of the kids had no active father figure in their lives. Then, the administration had the idea of asking the community for 50 community dads who would mentor these fatherless children. The result was 600 dads joining the young people for breakfast. That is a powerful example of sacrifice, service and love extended to the least of these.

There is no doubt that Jesus instructed and guided many of the men at this meeting. Once students, now they are teachers. They are teaching these low-income family children that they are special and important. I think they are teaching the world a thing or two, also.
