Keepin' It Real Ministry is working on plans for the **Thanksgiving Bash**. It is scheduled for 2:30-4:30 Sunday, November 12th on the stage in Finlay Park. They plan to bless the homeless community by distributing new backpacks with t-shirts and toiletries, and can always use donations of these items. They are also preparing to feed 500 people, and are seeking food commitments for 12 turkeys, 12 hams, 400 pieces of fried chicken, 500 servings of rice, 2 large pots of gravy, 500 servings of sweet potatoes, 500 servings of vegetables, and 500 sodas (they will be serving a similar meal on Christmas Day).

There are still open slots in their **Sunday afternoon worship meal schedule**. Available dates are, Oct 15, Nov. 26, Dec 17, Dec 24, and Dec 31st. They had many slots open this year because of the loss of several groups who moved on to other ministries. If you think your group might be interested in filling one of these slots, or dates in the 2018 schedule, please contact them. Sometimes it involves making a large pot of spaghetti, heating frozen foods, or providing sides.

Keepin' It Real has been assisting 100-120 people per week with **clothing and toiletries**. Men's clothing goes out as soon as it comes in. They need men's pants, waist sizes 30-40, but especially sizes 30-34. They also need shirts, belts, women's new bras, underwear, and ladies plus size clothes. Donations can be delivered to U-Haul Moving and Storage, 1037 Elmwood Avenue, or contact them to figure out an alternate location.

If you are interested in **volunteer opportunities**, Pastor Oscar and others distribute clothing at the U-Haul on Mondays and Fridays, and sort clothing on Wednesdays at 10 am. Please contact Pastor Oscar at 803.406.0724 if you would like to help. They will also have work sessions at the U-Haul on Saturday, October 7th at 1 pm, and a tentative work session on Saturday, Oct. 28th, in preparation for the Thanksgiving Bash.

You are welcome to join them for worship in Finlay Park on Sundays at 3 pm, or to attend board meetings every 1st Saturday of the month. The October 7th meeting will be at the U-Haul at 10 am, but please contact them for the location and time of future meetings.

They appreciate your prayers for their ministries, and are grateful that with your help they are able to assist the homeless, and share the love of Jesus. Thanks, and God bless!
